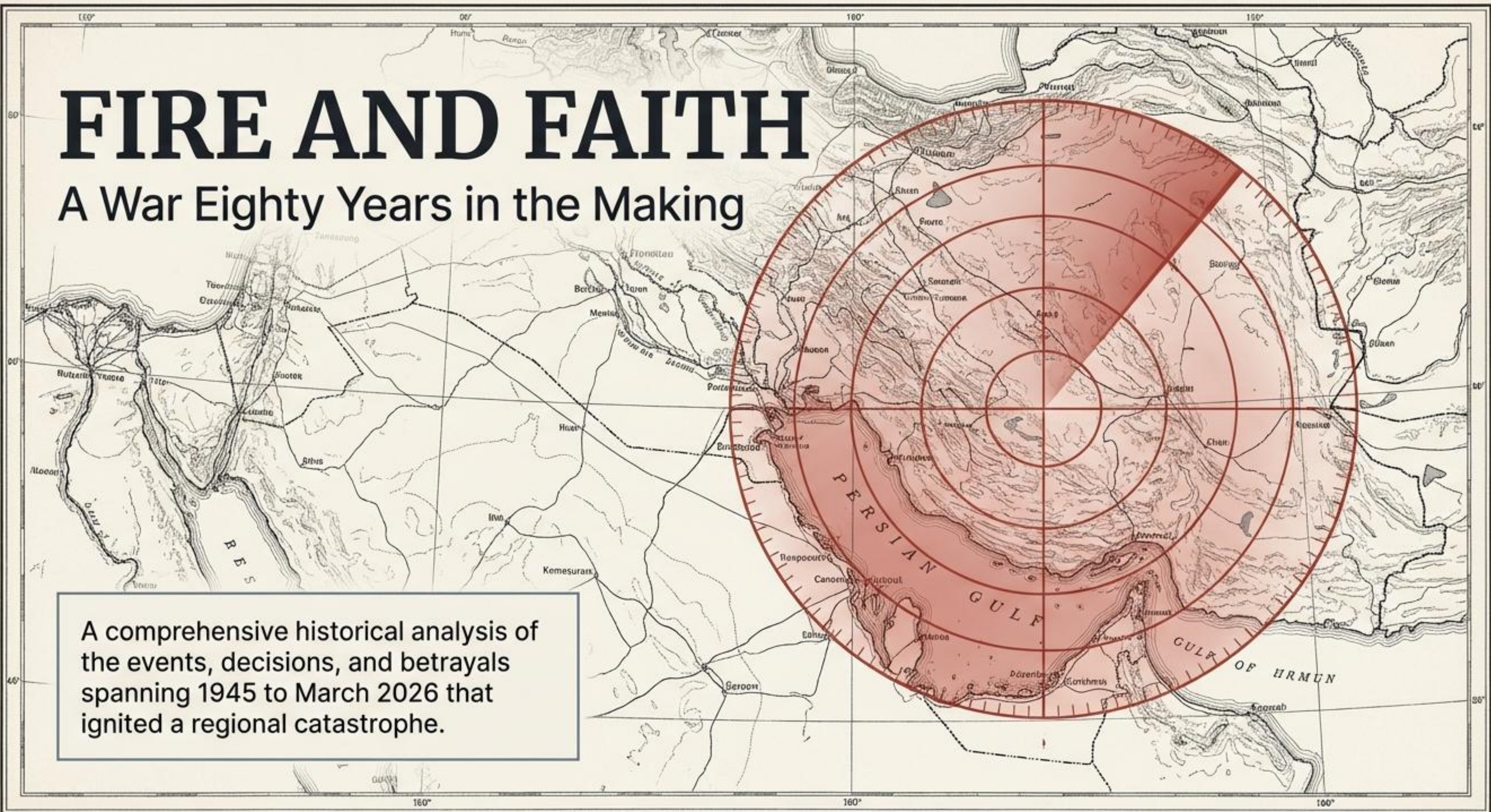

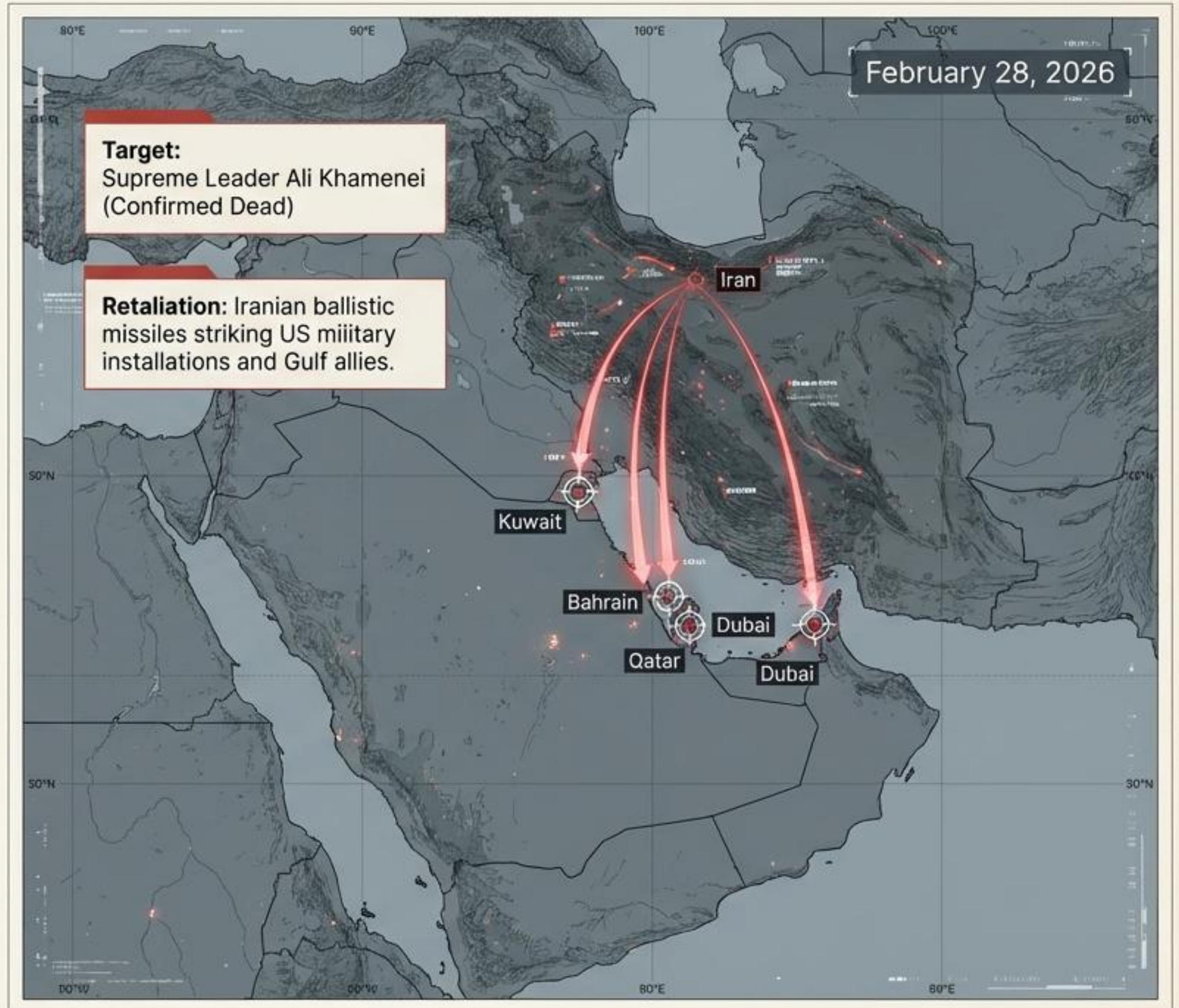


# The skies over Tehran light up with American and Israeli airstrikes, ending a 35-year reign

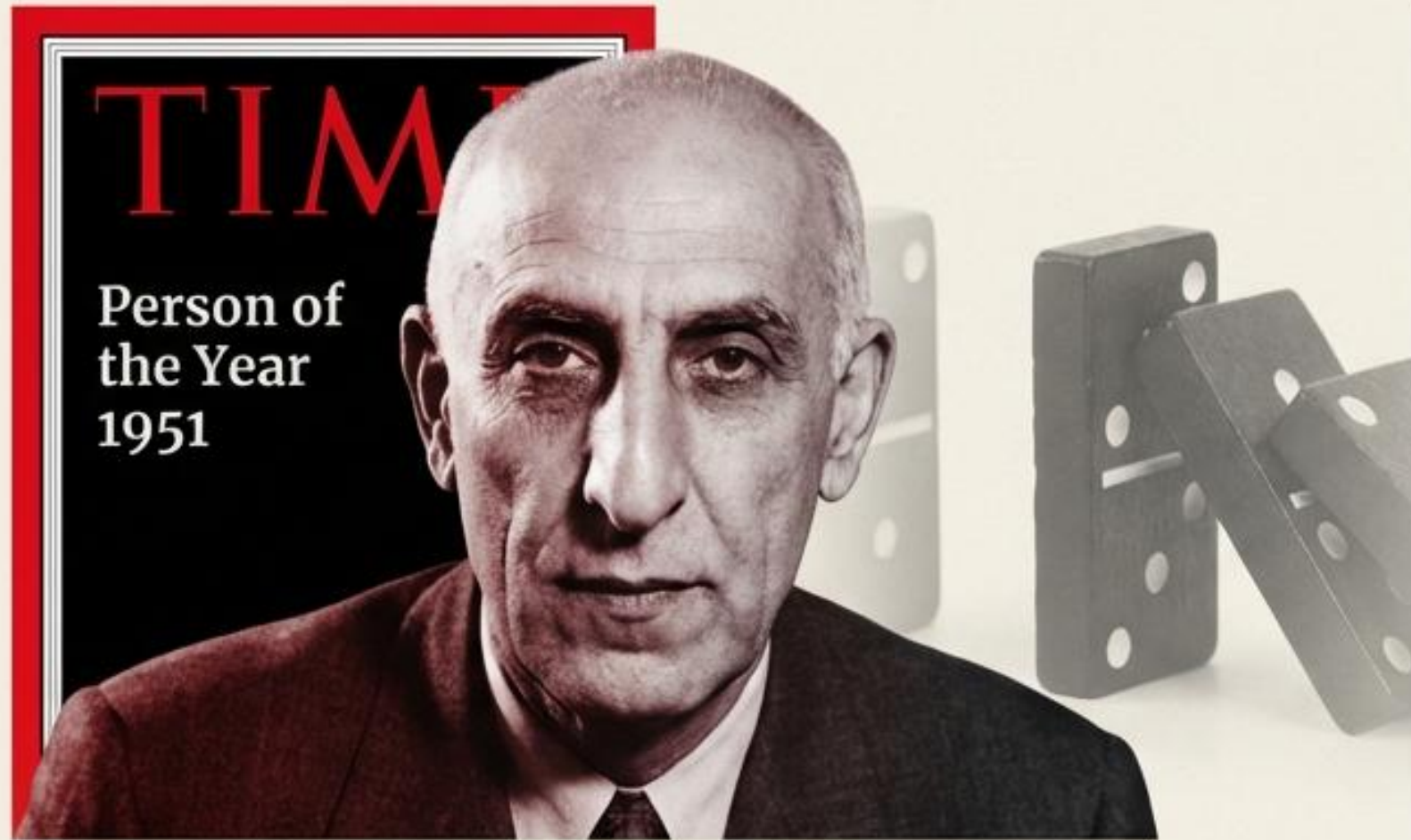
A conflict building for nearly eighty years has finally erupted into open war. But this war did not begin today.

It began in an oil field. It began with a CIA agent carrying cash through Tehran in 1953. It began with centrifuges spinning in the desert.

How did we get here?



# The strangulation of Iran's first and only democratic experiment



**The Catalyst:** In 1951, Prime Minister Mossaddegh nationalized the Anglo-Iranian Oil Company, **reclaiming Abadan—the world's largest refinery—from British control.**



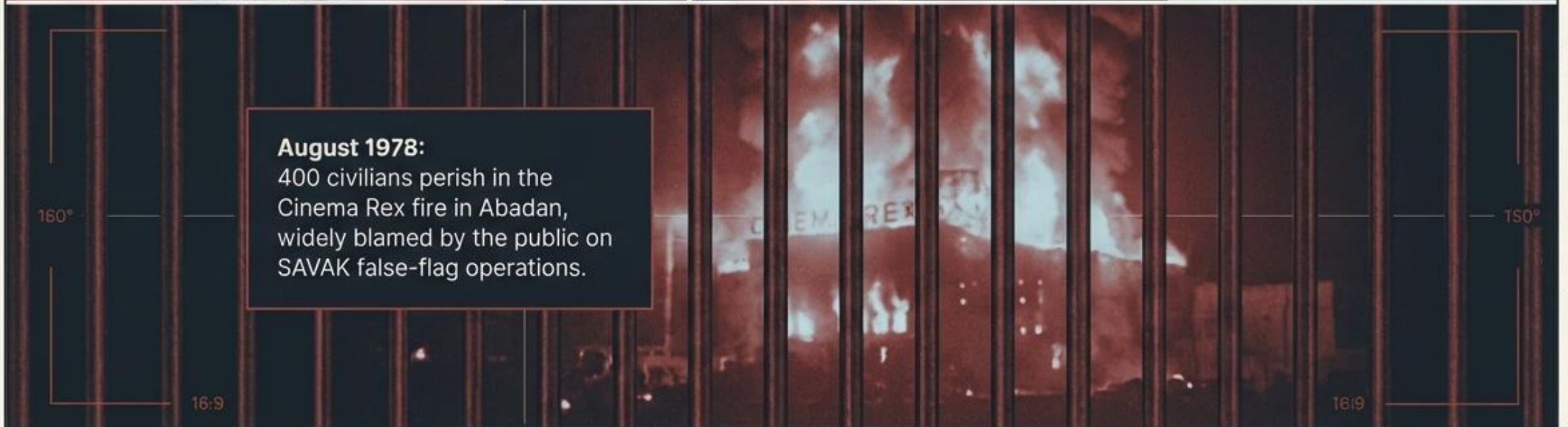
**The Reaction:** The Cold War lens framed oil nationalism as a Soviet threat. The CIA and MI6 executed **Operation Ajax**, utilizing **Kermit Roosevelt Jr., street gangs, and suitcases of cash** to overthrow the elected government.

“From the perspective of history, the coup was not successful for the United States. **The 1979 revolution was a long-term effect of the increasing repression from the Shah...**” — Stephen Kinzer, historian

# Billions in American weapons masked a society spiraling toward revolution

In 1953, after political unrest, Mosaddegh was removed and Mohammad Reza Pahlavi, who was the Shah (King) of Iran, took over. The Shah became America's closest Cold War ally, using oil wealth to build a formidable military.

On 19 August 1978, the Cinema Rex in Abadan was set on fire, killing over 400 civilians. SAVAK, Iran's secret police under Reza Pahlavi, was blamed. This acted as a massive catalyst towards removing the monarchy, the Shah.



# 444 days that transformed deep entanglement into declared, permanent enmity

Following the Shah's flight, 98% of iranians voted for an Islamic Republic. Khomeini consolidated power under Velayat-e Faqih (Guardianship of the Islamic Jurist), designating America the "Great Satan" and Israel the "Little Satan."

# A million dead and the brutal origins of Iran's nuclear ambition

Saddam Hussein's 1980 invasion galvanized the Islamic Republic. The eight-year war solidified Tehran's conviction that the West sought its destruction.

## Data Callouts

- **1,000,000+** estimated casualties on both sides.
- **Chemical Warfare:** Unleashed by Iraq using precursors supplied by Western companies.
- **Iran-Contra:** Reagan officials illegally sold weapons to Tehran to fund Nicaraguan rebels and free Hezbollah-held hostages.
- **Flight 655:** US Navy shoots down an Iranian civilian airliner in 1988, killing 290.



# From strategic Cold War partners to existential ideological enemies

## Pre-1979: The Unlikely Alliance



- **Strategy:** "Periphery Doctrine" - Shared threats of Arab nationalism and Soviet influence.



- **Operations:** SAVAK and Mossad joint training; intelligence sharing.



- **Economics:** Trans-Israel pipeline; Israel owes Iran \$1 billion for oil debts by 1978.

## Post-1979: The Rupture



- **Ideology:** Israel branded the illegitimate "Zionist Regime."

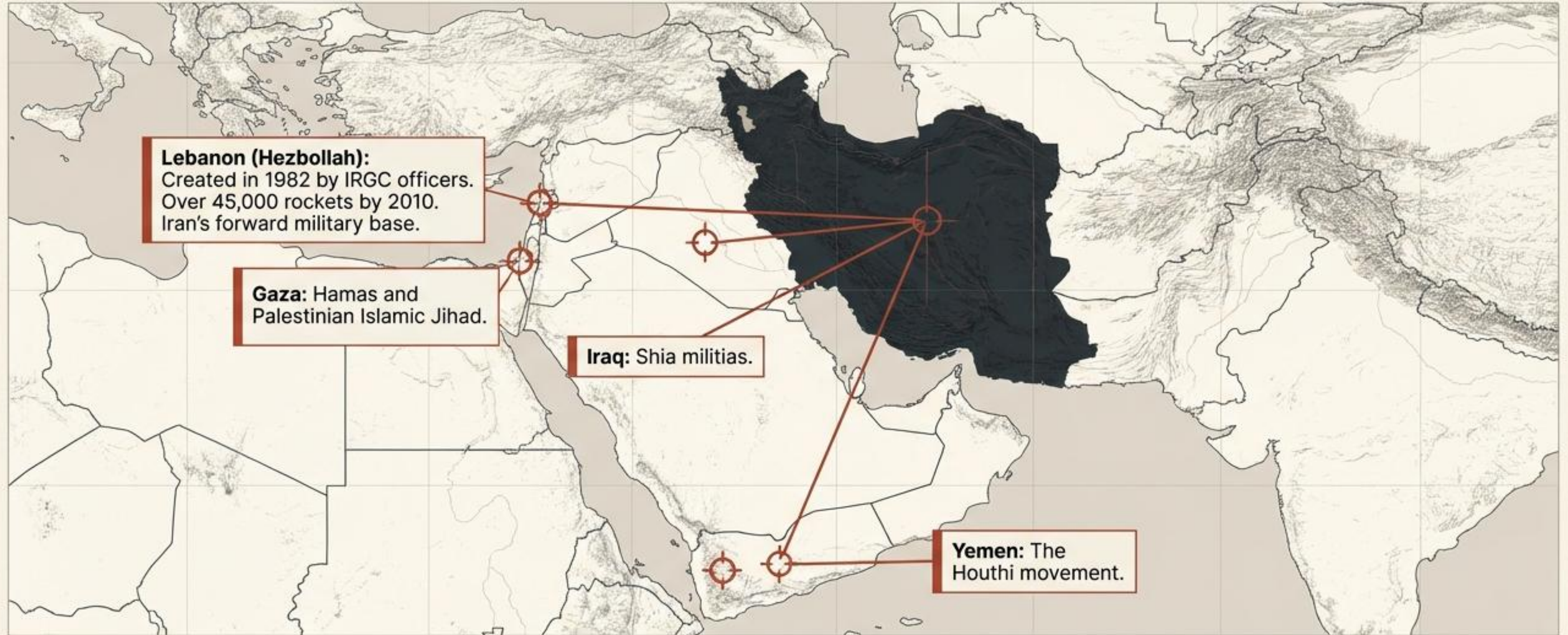


- **Diplomacy:** Israeli Embassy keys in Tehran handed to Yasser Arafat's PLO.



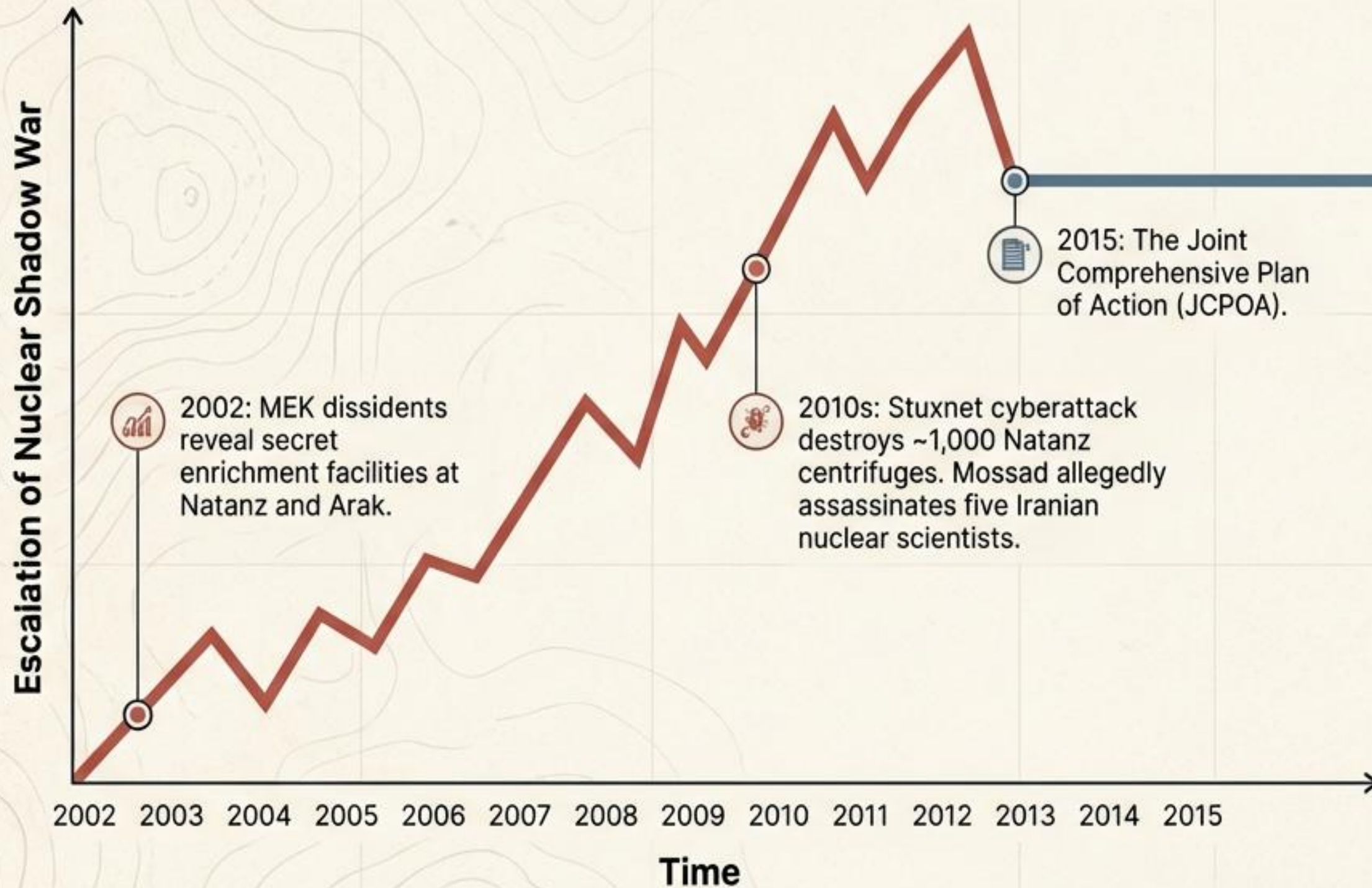
- **Geopolitics:** Anti-Zionism becomes the vehicle for Iran to claim leadership of the broader Muslim world over Saudi Arabia.

# Encircling the adversary through the Axis of Resistance



Succeeding Khomeini in 1989, Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei engineered a durable strategy to project power without triggering direct US retaliation. By funding, training, and arming non-state proxy groups, Iran effectively forced Israel to prepare for a multi-front war while maintaining plausible deniability.

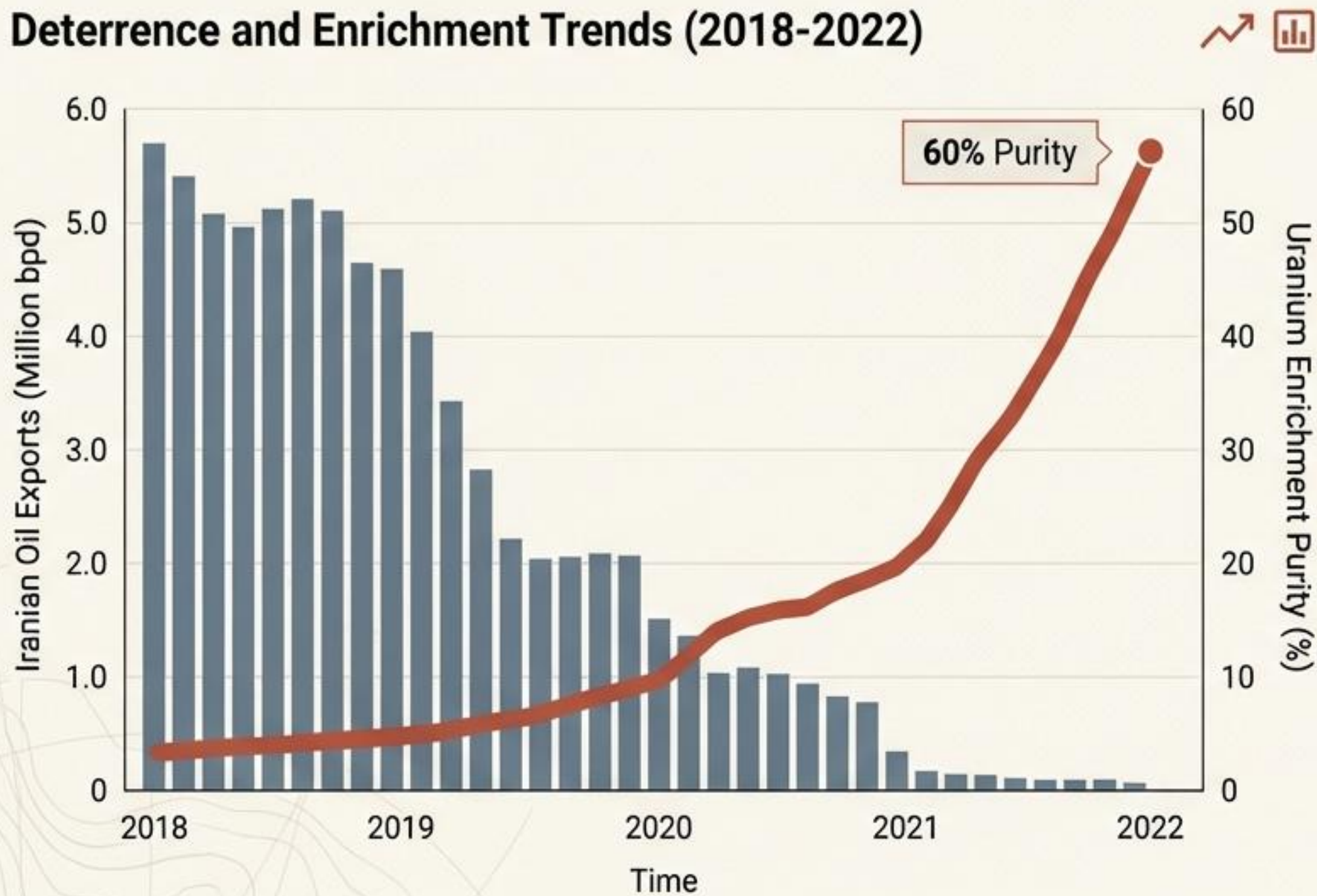
# Covert sabotage, assassinations, and the diplomatic off-ramp that held



The JCPOA was the most significant diplomatic achievement in the Middle East since the Oslo Accords. Iran agreed to drastically limit enrichment and accept rigorous international inspections in exchange for the lifting of devastating economic sanctions. For three years, the agreement successfully contained the nuclear threat.

## Key Events Board

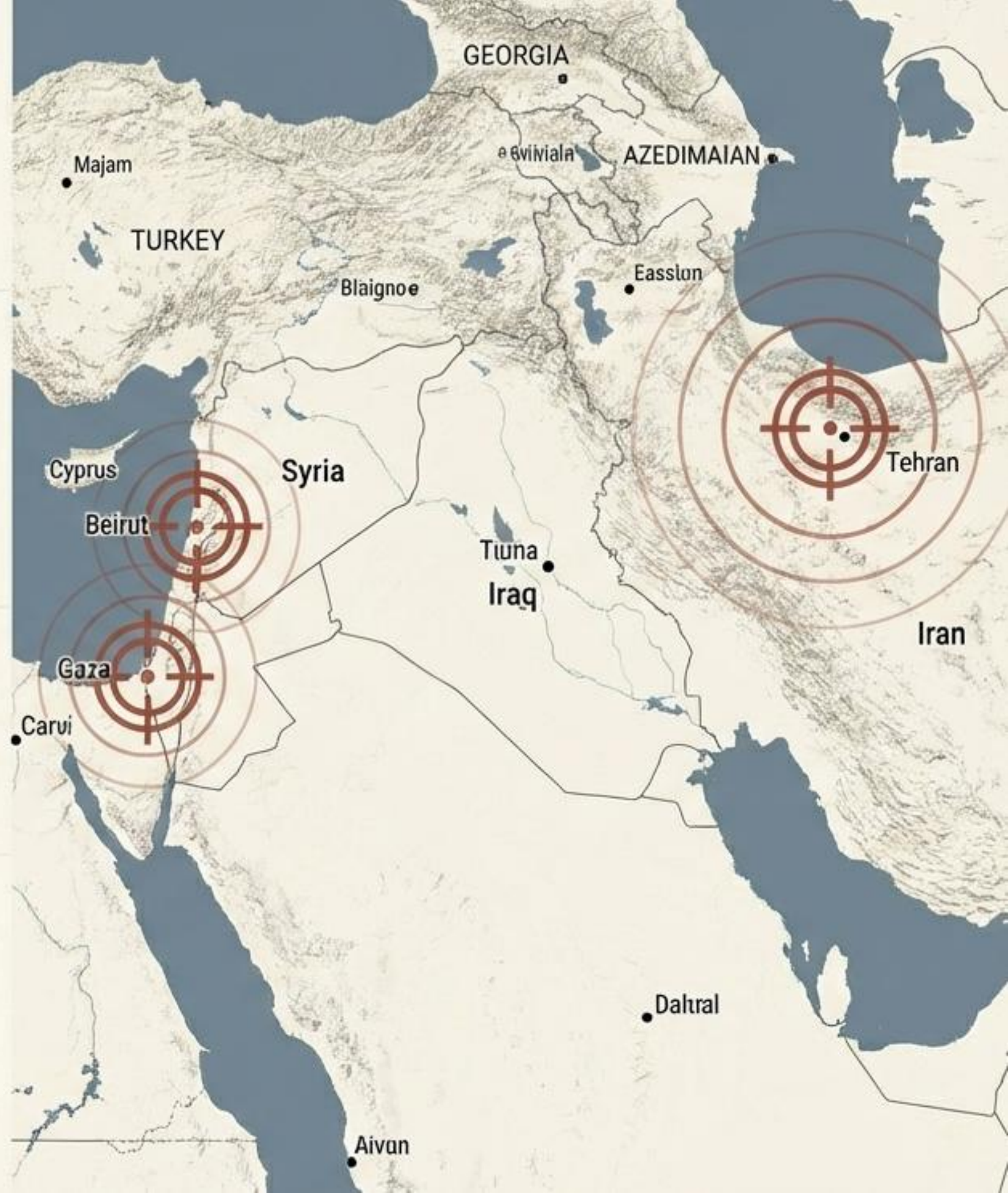
- May 2018**  
President Trump unilaterally withdraws the US from the functioning JCPOA over the objections of European allies.
- Jan 3, 2020**  
US drone strike in Baghdad kills Quds Force Commander Qasem Soleimani, the architect of the Axis of Resistance. Iran retaliates with ballistic missiles on US bases.
- Jan 2020**  
Revolutionary Guard forces on high alert accidentally shoot down commercial Flight 752, killing 176 and shattering domestic regime legitimacy.
- 2022**  
Biden administration diplomacy fails. The JCPOA window closes permanently.

# Hamas ignites a regional war, and Israel dismantles the proxy ring

On October 7, 2023, Hamas launched an attack killing approximately 1,200 Israelis and taking 250 hostages. Though Iran denied operational involvement, the massacre was the product of the infrastructure of violence Tehran spent decades building.

## Decapitation Timeline:

- **April & Oct 2024:** First-ever direct missile exchanges between Iranian territory and Israel.
- **July 2024:** Hamas political leader Ismail Haniyeh assassinated in a humiliated Tehran.
- **September 2024:** Israel eliminates Hezbollah Secretary-General Hassan Nasrallah in Beirut, inflicting a generational strategic blow to Iran's proxy network.



# A cornered regime faces devastating airstrikes and internal revolution

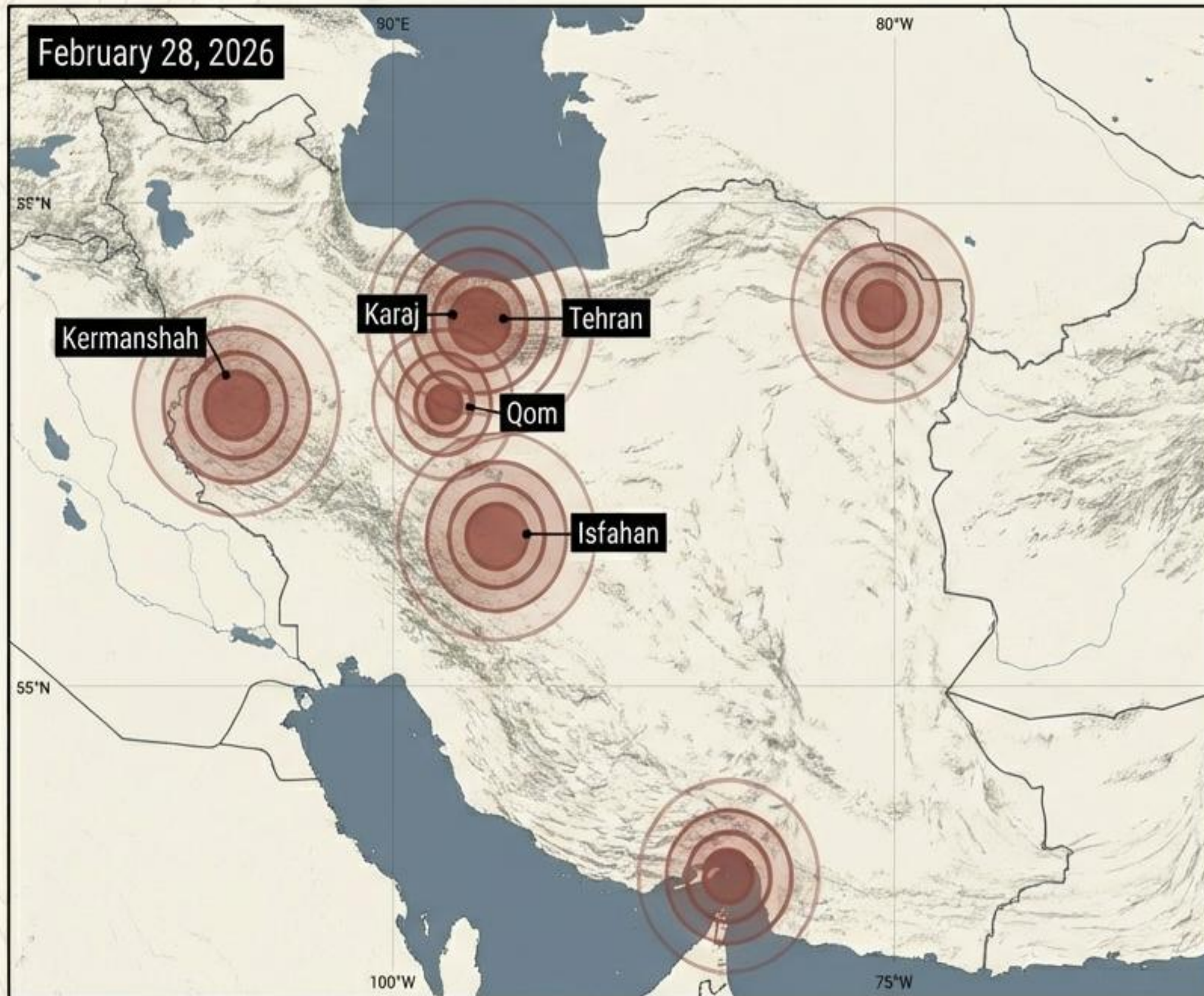


**June 2025 (Operation Rising Lion):** Israel and the US launch coordinated bunker-buster strikes on Iranian military and nuclear sites.

**Dec 2025 - Jan 2026:** The largest civil unrest since 1979 erupts across 100+ cities over economic collapse. Security forces massacre hundreds of protesters.

**"We are watching. Help is on the way."** — President Donald Trump, addressing the Iranian people during the protests.

# Operation Epic Fury and the unprecedented assassination of a head of state



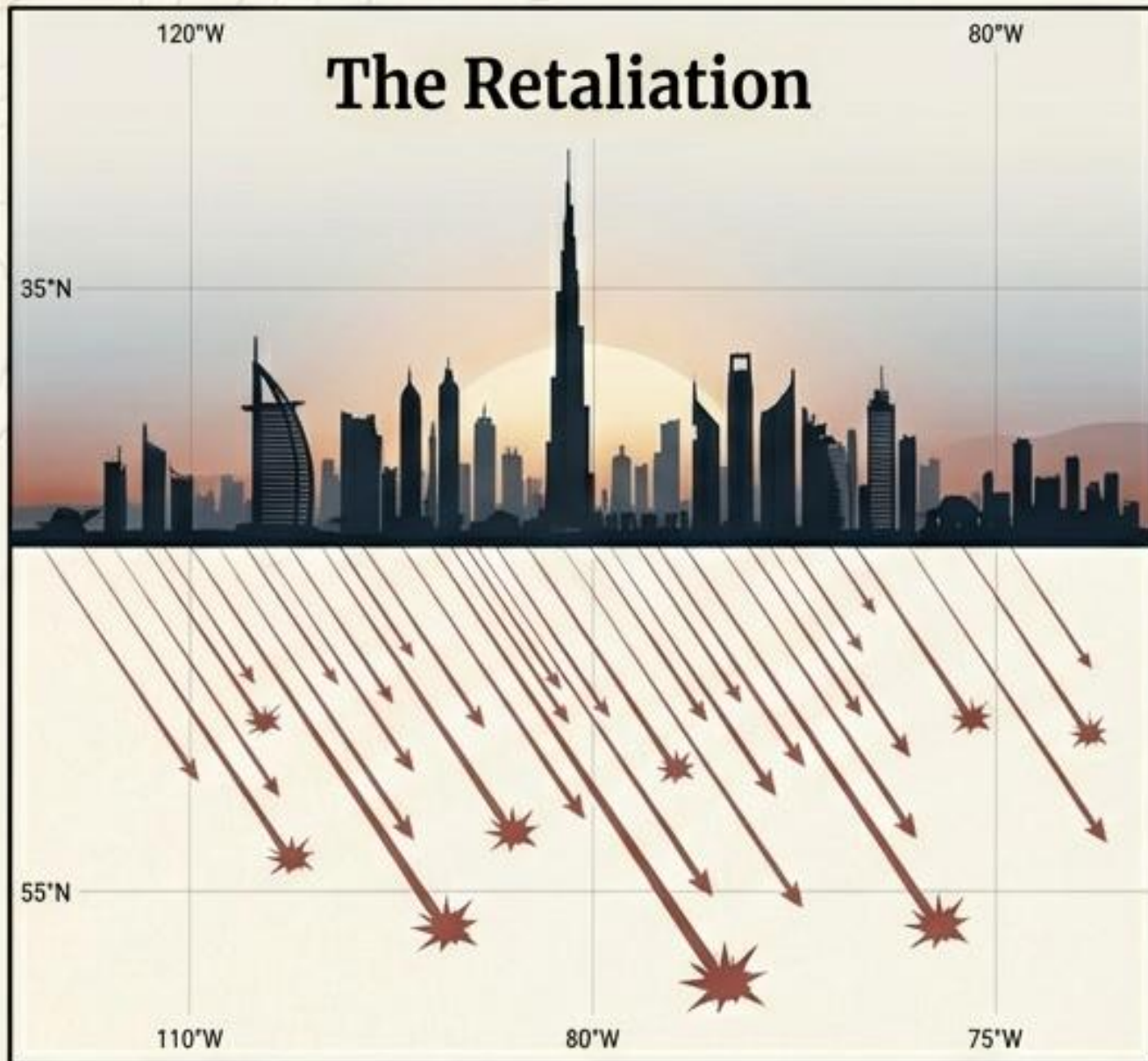
Following IAEA discoveries of hidden highly enriched uranium, the United States launched the **largest military buildup** in two decades.

## Tactical Breakdown:

- **Force Posture:** 120+ US aircraft deployed to the region.
- **The Strike:** Coordinated US-Israeli assault on air defenses, missile production, and nuclear sites.
- **The Tipping Point:** A targeted strike on the Supreme Leader's compound kills Ali Khamenei, erasing the last direct link to the 1979 revolution.

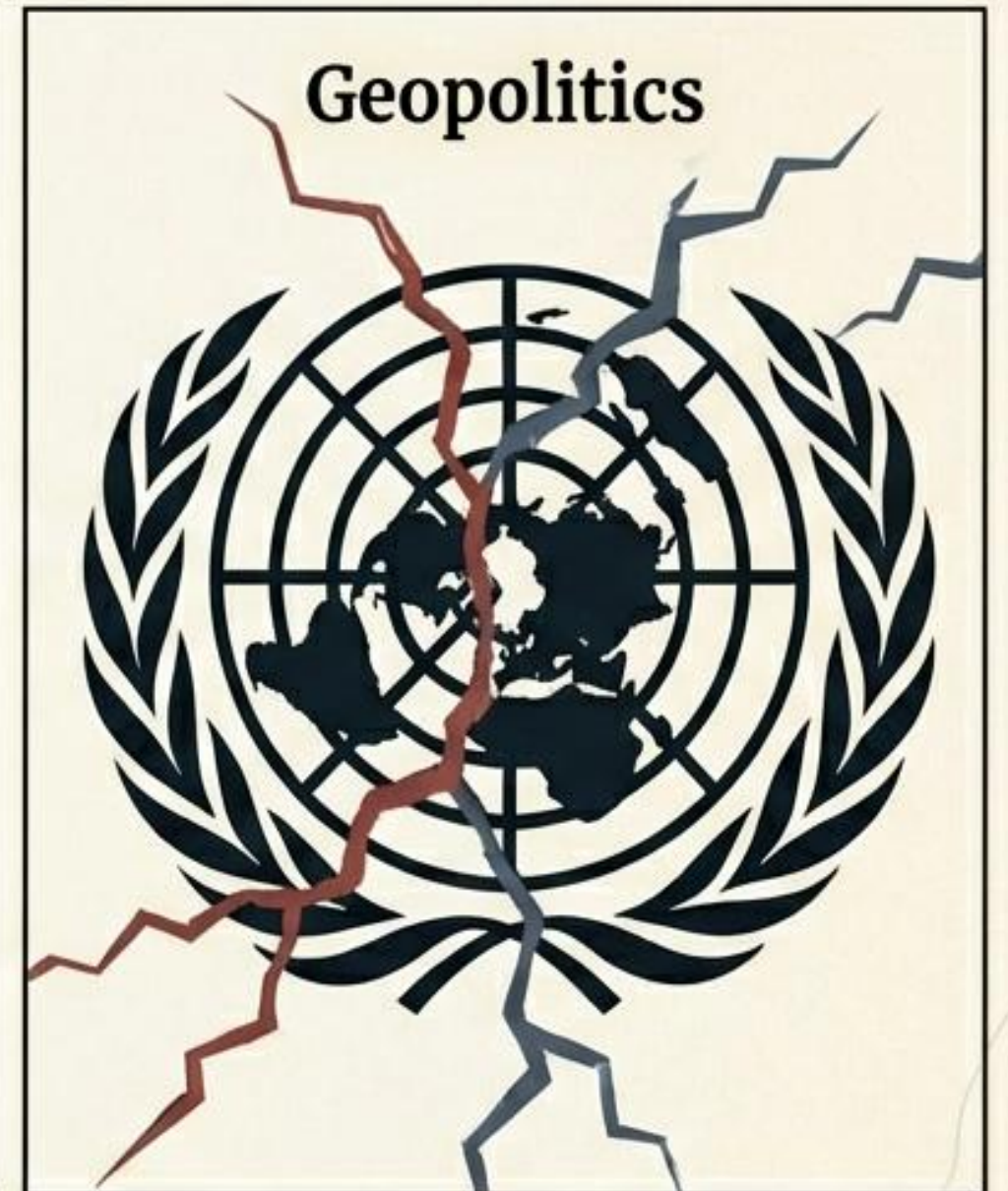
# The region burns as energy markets brace for a global supply shock



**The Retaliation:** 137 ballistic missiles and 209 drones strike the UAE alone on day one. Debris hits Dubai's Burj Al Arab and shuts down the world's busiest airport. Casualties: 3 US soldiers killed, 5 wounded. Over 200 Iranian civilians dead.

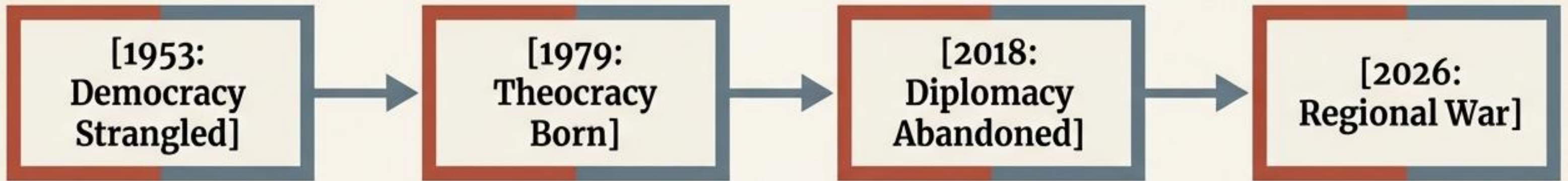


**Economic Shock:** Oil, gold, and silver prices surge as 20% of the world's oil flow through the Strait of Hormuz is threatened.



**Geopolitics:** The UN, Russia, and China condemn the US/Israeli strikes. The UK permits defensive use of British bases. A succession crisis paralyzes Tehran.

# Military solutions repeatedly failed to solve historical and political problems



## Historical Context

The crisis of 2026 did not emerge from nowhere. It is the fruit of eighty years of deferred justice, cold war oil politics, and betrayed hopes.

- The 1953 coup destroyed democratic evolution, breeding sustained autocracy.
- The Shah's autocracy birthed Khomeini's revolution, creating a regime that required ideological enemies.
- Proxy wars and abandoned diplomatic off-ramps guaranteed an explosive collision.

**Final Takeaway:** Mohammad Mossadegh never saw a free Iran. Whether a sovereign, prosperous, and free Iranian nation can finally emerge from the ashes of this catastrophic conflict remains the most consequential open question in the world.
